Professor George Leontsinis will make a presentation on Greek historical migration. He will specifically discuss internal migration (within Greece, say from the island of Crete to Athens). Professor Leontsinis will also discuss aspects of the Greek external migration experience with special emphasis on Greek migration to Australia. Professor Leontsinis will encourage discussion on all aspect of the issues raised in his presentation.

Professor George Leontsinis, has held the Chair of Modern Greek History and Teaching of History, The University of Athens, Greece, since 1997. He has a distinguished record of research in aspects of the Greek migration experience and on the theoretical and methodological aspects of the teaching of history. He has published extensively in both these fields. After graduation from the School of Philosophy of The University of Athens, he completed his PhD at The University of East Anglia in the School of European History. He engaged in postdoctoral research at The University of London and since then has held academic appointments at The Ionian University in Corfu and at The University of Athens.

For many years Professor Leontsinis has been a member of the Committee of the Trifylleion Foundation of Athens as well as a member of the Kytherian Societies of Athens and of Piraeus. In 2004 Professor Leontsinis received the Aroney's Award from The University of Athens for his book *Theoretical and Methodological Questions of the Teaching of History and the Environment* [Athens 2003].
