Dominique Ristori was appointed to the European Commission in 1978. Following his appointment in 1996 as Director responsible for energy policy, in 2000 he became Director responsible for General Affairs and Resources within the Directorate General for energy and transport. This position covered, for both energy and transport, the areas of financial resources and activity based management; personnel, training and information technology; inter-institutional relations, enlargement and international relations; internal market (including State aids) and competition and services of general economic interest and users' rights.

In August 2006 Dominique Ristori was appointed Deputy Director General within the Directorate-General for energy and transport, particularly in charge of nuclear affairs.
