SPEAKER: MR ALAN SEATTER, EUROPEAN COMMISSION

Abstract: Mr Seatter will address the priorities of the EU in their global context, as it moves to play an increasing role in world affairs at a time of challenges in the fields of the economy, security and the environment.

Biography: Mr Seatter is responsible within the Directorate-General for External Relations, for relations with the USA, Canada, Japan, Korea, DPRK, Australia, New Zealand, EFTA, EEA and Switzerland. He has recently been heavily involved in the Commission's contacts with the new US administration and is in Australia for a Senior Officials Meeting between European Commission and Australian officials. He has an MA (first class honours) in Philosophy and Economics from University College, Oxford, and has lectured in Mathematics, Economics and Statistics at Worcester College and Nuffield College, Oxford University.
