

WHAT IS A NON-AWARD COURSE?

A non-award course is a program of study which does not lead to an awardⁱ and which comprises a unit or units of study which:

- is a unit or units of study from an award course or courses at the institution; and
- is able to be counted as credit towards some award course at the institution by all students who complete the unit or units of study.

ⁱ a program of study formally approved/accredited by the institution or any other relevant accreditation authority and which leads to an academic award granted by the institution or which qualifies a student to enter a course at a level higher than a bachelor's degree. It includes courses of an equivalent nature undertaken overseas.
