

APPEALS

Appeals will only be considered against process issues and not against Research Advisory Board or Expert Review Committee decisions, ratings and comments. An appeal must be lodged on the appropriate form and must be received within 28 days of the date on the letter notifying the outcomes of applications.

Appeals Process: Stage 1

1. Appeal addressed to the Director, APHCRI, Building 62, Cnr Mills and Eggleston Roads, The Australian National University, Canberra ACT 0200.
2. Receipt of Appeal at APHCRI hub
3. Acknowledgement of Appeal
4. Appeals will be considered at the next meeting of the Research Advisory Board (RAB)
5. Outcome of RAB deliberations on the Appeal communicated to Appellant

➡ Appellant accepts outcome – process ends

Appeals Process: Stage 2

➡ Appellant does not accept outcome

6. Appellant writes to the Director, APHCRI, Building 62, Cnr Mills and Eggleston Roads, The Australian National University, Canberra ACT 0200.
7. APHCRI receives a response from the Appellant indicating that they are not satisfied with the response received from the RAB.
8. Acknowledgement of Appeal, with process and expected timeline for resolution.
9. All documentation forwarded to the DVC Research for final consideration.
10. Outcome of deliberation of DVC Research communicated to Appellant.
