Mosaics for Everyone

Mosaics is something that anyone with any level of skill can do. The aim of this class is to provide the skills necessary to design and apply mosaics onto a two dimensional surface. Once this is achieved and if desired, students can adopt a more sculptural approach by building wire armatures to be cemented and ultimately mosaiced.

Students in this class will be guided on an individual basis and at their own level of skill. They can expect to complete at least one project and more depending on the scale and intricacy of the pieces. A variety of materials can be used ranging from your grandmother's old china to your collection of beach detritus. All tools and materials will be provided for the first class but it is advisable to bring a work-shirt and safety goggles.

A materials fee of \$50 each is included in the cost of your course for glue, grout, cement board, tiles, cement, sand and wire. This is everything you will need for at least your first project. You may wish to buy other incidentals including your own tool at a later date. I will provide a list of materials and suppliers at the first class.
