Course Outline:

The Portfolio Preparation classes are designed to assist students in developing their own working processes centered on visual creativity and the preparation of a portfolio for submission to an Art School or a similar course of study.

The course is structured to cover the principle requirements to produce a balanced visual portfolio. Lessons are arranged to aid the student find their own voice in a wide variety of disciplines including: General drawing from observation, life drawing, painting, block printing and portfolio evaluation.

The emphasis of this course is placed on the preparation of an art portfolio showing the student's individual sense of drawing, colour use, and design by utilizing a variety of art media.
