Water colour painting - Intermediate

This class is the next step on from the beginners class, and would also be ideal for those who already have watercolour skills and would like to further their knowledge of water media techniques. This class deals with supplementary elements to transparent watercolour, gouache (opaque watercolour) combining both transparent and opaque, pen and ink plus aquarelle pencils.

The media studied during the semester are divided into four separate projects each lasting three weeks.

They are:

- 1 Gouache (opaque watercolour)
- 2 Combining watercolour & opaque
- 3 Watercolour and pen and ink techniques
- 4 Aquarelle pencils (watercolour)

The different techniques, materials, additives and various compositional devices for the supplementary elements are each demonstrated and explained fully to students. Working from source material, still life and nature, the student by the end of the semester will have acquired a comprehensive understanding of the various systems required for competent water media work.

The semester will conclude with students working "mixed media" works.
