Learn or revise the basics of colour darkroom printing or continue with an independent project.

Would suit beginners or continuing students. Participants will be encouraged and supported to pursue printing in a creative and independent manner. Darkroom time will be optimised for experimentation and the development of ideas and concepts. Technical instruction will be offered in the first four weeks for those who need to lay foundations in the medium. There will be individual consultations and feedback together with occasional, but optional, group critiques. An all-day mural printing session may be arranged for one Saturday at a convenient time to suit interested participants.

Need to bring: Own negatives, negative sleeves and folder, photographic paper 8x10 inches (20x25 cm) or larger.
