Discover the rewarding journey of blending colours and textures using a variety of materials including wool, cotton, rags, string, plastic bags and other recycled material! Students will cover every aspect of the traditional Tapestry weaving techniques. These include, designing the cartoon, warping up, combining various materials to achieve an exciting visual feast and finishing off techniques. By the end of the course students will have the skills to continue weaving this weft faced textile at home

Tapestry weaving is suitable for all levels, no experience is necessary. During the course we will design a tapestry, warp up the loom, learn to blend colors and introduce other materials for interest. This is an expressive medium giving flexibility to create individual pieces.

Recommended for Beginners, Intermediate

Students to provide Scissors, black marker pen, ruler, collection of woollen yarns, fabrics for weaving, ideas for design
