3D Weaving & Learning to Weave

Enjoy adventures in weaving! Suitable for beginner/intermediate weavers. Beginners will be introduced to the loom, fibres and 4 shaft weave structures. Intermediate weavers will explore several set-ups to create lush 3D-textures. Participants work on their own skill level and will be guided to translate learned techniques into a personal project of a practical or decorative nature.

Session 1-6 weave introduction to structures. Session 7-12 for individual projects. Participants can work on their own skill level and at their own pace.

3D weaving structures will include waffle weave, supplementary warp, seersucker, feting processes combining weaving wool with silk/cotton/rayon.

Note: session 2-3 and 9-10 are full days on a Saturday (25 Feb and March 31) scheduled in the course

Table looms (4-8 shafts), weaving equipment and yarn all supplied.

Participants can also use their own yarn and or loom to work with at home between classes.
