Complete the *College of Science Application for Current ANU Student for Admission to Honours Program* and forward it with a copy of your academic results from ISIS to the Department of Psychology, ANU, Canberra 0200 ACT

If you are:

An external student or an ANU student who has completed their Pass degree and have not applied for program leave

Complete an *Undergraduate Application* form and forward it to Student Admissions
AND

Complete the *Department of Psychology Supplementary Information for Honours in Psychology* and forward it with a copy of your academic results to the Department of Psychology, ANU, Canberra 0200 ACT

Humanities students²

If you are:

A current ANU Arts studentⁱⁱ or an ANU Arts student who has completed their Pass degree and applied for program leave

Complete the *Application for Admission to Honours - Faculty of Arts*, and forward it to the College of Arts & Social Sciences Student Office

AND

Complete the *Department of Psychology Supplementary Information for Honours in Psychology* and forward it with a copy of your academic results from ISIS to the Department of Psychology, ANU, Canberra 0200 ACT

If you are:

An external humanities/arts student or an ANU Arts student who has completed their Pass degree and have not applied for program leave
