**The Australian National University
Terrell International Scholarships (25% and 50%)
TERMS AND CONDITIONS**

Preamble

To commemorate the contribution of Professor R D Terrell to international relations and international student affairs, the University has established a number of **Terrell International Undergraduate Scholarships** to be awarded to international undergraduate students on the basis of their achievement in their enrolment at the Australian National University.

Title

The scholarships will be called the Australian National University Terrell International Scholarships I - VIII.

Award

Each year the award of the Terrell International Scholarships will be approved by the Chair of the University Committee.

Eligibility

The Scholarships will be awarded to international undergraduate students (for the purpose of these Terms and Conditions an international student is the same as an Overseas Student defined in Section 3 of the *Higher Education Funding Act 1988*) who have completed two academic semesters on a full time basis.

Criteria

An eligible international student must apply to the University to be considered for the award of a Scholarship. The Scholarships will be awarded on the basis of academic merit as evidenced by overall achievement in the applicant's enrolment at the Australian National University.

Other Awards

A Scholar may, with the permission of the University Awards Committee, hold other scholarships and awards, both those specifically for tuition and also those where the scholarship is paid to the scholar. If other scholarships or awards are held the value of the Terrell International Scholarship will be reduced by the amount by which the total value of all other awards held exceed either 50% or 75% (depending on the type of Terrell International Scholarship held) of the total tuition cost of the Scholar's enrolment in any year.

Tenure

The Scholarships will be awarded for the remaining duration of any undergraduate program or combined program (including an Honours year) registered by the University on the Commonwealth Register of Institutions and Courses for Overseas Students (CRICOS) in which the Scholar is enrolled. Scholars must be enrolled on a full time basis unless otherwise approved by the University Awards Committee.

Benefits

Four of the Scholarships (Scholarships I-IV) will meet one half (50%) and four (Scholarships V-VIII) will meet one quarter (25%) of the cost of the tuition fees for the remaining minimum duration of any undergraduate program or combined program (including an Honours year) registered by the University on CRICOS. The scholarships also meet 100% of the single Overseas Student Health Cover. No stipend, travel, removal or incidental costs are payable under the scholarship. The type of the scholarship (25% or 50%) will be set in the letter of offer.

Deferment

The Scholarships may not be deferred.

Suspension

During the program and with the approval of the relevant College and the University Awards Committee, the Scholarships may be suspended for a maximum total period of one year in circumstances where Scholars apply to suspend their candidature for the degree for reasons beyond their control.

Transfer of Program

Any scholar who wishes to transfer to another degree program must obtain the written approval of the relevant ANU College and the University Awards Committee. The scholarship will not be extended beyond the original minimum program duration.

Level of Performance

Terrell International Scholars are responsible for their academic achievement which is expected to be at the appropriate level which means a Distinction average in each semester (with the average being across all courses taken in a particular semester) as set out in the Policy for Academic Progress for Undergraduate Scholarship Holders is located at:

Termination

The University Awards Committee may terminate the Scholarships:

1. if in the Committee's opinion the Scholars have failed to make satisfactory academic progress;
2. if the Scholars withdraw, abandon or otherwise terminate their candidature.

Permanent Residency in Australia

Scholars who obtain Australian Permanent Residence will cease to be eligible to hold the scholarship from the end of the semester in which they receive Permanent Residence Status.
