3. ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

- The deadline for submission of application is **COB, 29 March 2020**.
- In the event the Scholarship is awarded, the recipient may be requested to participate in publicity for the *Primate Conservation Travel Grant* Scholarship. Scholars may be contacted for an interview and photograph. Please refer to the Conditions of Award document for further details.
- In addition, the Scholarship recipient will be required to forward a letter of appreciation to the donors within 1-2 weeks of notification of receiving the Scholarship. At the conclusion of their program the Scholarship Recipient will be required to provide a final report detailing how the Scholarship has benefitted their studies. The final report should be submitted no later than one month after the conclusion of the proposed travel period. Both the letter of appreciation and the final report should be addressed to the *Primate Conservation Travel Grant Foundation* and submitted to the *CASS Scholarships and Prizes Officer* (awards.cass@anu.edu.au) so it can be forwarded to the donors.
