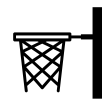

OUR FACILITIES AND SERVICES

Members can access events, networks, workshops, pastoral care, peer support, leadership opportunities, trainings, professional development opportunities and trainings offered by Griffin Hall.

A dedicated common room equipped with facilities such as study area, lounge area and a pantry is also available for members.

Support

A team of Community Assistants are available to provide peer support to members. Student leaders are also supported by ANU staff members (Non-Residential Hall Coordinator).
