GATENBY PRIZE FOR EXCELLENCE IN INTERNAL MEDICINE

Conditions of Award

1. There shall be a prize of \$500 for award each year, which shall be known as the 'Gatenby Prize for Excellence in Internal Medicine'.
2. The prize shall be awarded to the student who, in that year:
 - (i) was enrolled in Year Four of the Bachelor of Medicine Bachelor of Surgery (MBBS) – Doctor of Medicine, Doctor of Surgery (MChD) Program in the ANU College of Medicine, Biology and Environment; AND
 - a. was in the top 25 students in internal medicine in year 3 who will be short-listed for consideration of the award in the following year; AND
 - b. received the highest mark in year 4 medicine as determined by the written paper (one third of marks), OSCEs (one third) and long case exam (one third).
3. In the event of more than one student having the same (top) mark in year 4 medicine, the prize will be shared.
4. The Dean of Medicine and Health Sciences shall determine the Selection Committee, which shall include the ANUMS Professor of Medicine and two other experienced physicians appointed to the panel by the Professor of Medicine.
5. The Panel of Examiners in Medicine will recommend a winner to the Dean.
6. If, in any year, no student is assessed, in the opinion of the Dean of Medicine and Health Sciences, as justifying the award of the prize in that year, the prize shall not be awarded in that year.
