SCHOOL OF ART DRAWING PRIZE

Conditions of Award

1. There shall be a prize to the value of \$1000 awarded each year, that shall be known as the School of Art Drawing Prize.
2. The prize will be open to students enrolled in any of the following course code courses: ARTV; DESA; DESN; and ARTH in the second semester of the year of the award.
3. The prize will be open to accept submissions. A panel of academic staff of the ANU School of Art nominated by the Head of School will make a short list for exhibition.
4. Short-listed works will be exhibited by the ANU School of Art Gallery in association with the University's Open Day which is usually held in August each year.
5. The winning work(s) shall be selected, on the basis of artistic merit, either by a visiting artist who has been nominated by the Head of School or by the Head of School, as determined from time to time.
6. If, in any year, the Judge selects more than one winning work, the prize in that year shall be divided equally between the winners.
7. The winning work(s) shall be publicised in the ANU SOA Gallery on Open Day.
9. If, in any year, Dean of the College of Arts and Social Sciences accepts the recommendation of the Judge that no work justifies receipt of the prize, the prize shall not be awarded in that year.

This prize was originally established and is supported by Jan Brown, former long serving member of staff and Head of Foundation at the ANU School of Art and an important Australian artist.
