

UNIVERSITY MEDAL NOMINATION INFORMATION

The University Medal recognises students who have obtained First Class Honours (or Masters Advanced Equivalent) and demonstrated exceptional academic excellence across their studies in their final semester of study. This includes Semester 1 or Semester 2, 2020.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION

Students who are completing an AQF 8 qualification (bachelor honours) or AQF 9 or 9E qualification (Masters Advanced program of at least 96 units) are eligible for nomination.

Semester 1, 2020:

Potential nominees are those students who have a GPA over 6.5 after the finalisation of Semester 1, 2020 results.

Semester 2, 2020:

Potential nominees are students who have a GPA of at least 6.0 before the finalisation of Semester 2, 2020 results. This is to capture students who perform at a high level in their last semester, and therefore reach the required 6.5 GPA.

They are broken down as Honours and Masters cohorts.

Each College may recommend for the award of a Medal up to 3% of each the Honours and Masters graduating cohort. Please note you do not have to exhaust your allocation.

Please note that Medals are no longer awarded in disciplines, but as ANU University Medal. Only one nomination can be accepted from each discipline for Honours level, and one for Masters Advanced level.

SUPPORTING DOCUMENTS THAT MUST BE INCLUDED:

When compiling a nomination for a student, supporting documentation must be provided with the nomination form. Supporting documentation must include any examiner reports, comparisons to previous medal winners, and a whole of College ranking list. The nomination may also include letters of support from honours convenors and supervisors.

It is essential that all information requested is provided - failure to do so may put a nomination in jeopardy.

WHEN THE FORMS ARE DUE:

Determination of these awards will be made by the University Medals Committee. In order to be considered at the end of year meeting all complete nominations must be received by:

MIDNIGHT 8th December 2020

WHERE THE FORMS ARE DUE:

All endorsed nominations must be sent as a single pdf file per student to Prizes@anu.edu.au. No hard copy or late nominations will be accepted due to tight turnaround times.
