## GERMAN EMBASSY PRIZES FOR GERMAN LANGUAGE AND CULTURE

## **Conditions of Award**

- 1. There shall be four prizes for award each year which shall be known as the German Embassy Prizes for German Language and Culture.
- 2. The prizes shall be valued at \$100 each.
- 3. One prize shall be awarded to the student who achieved the best result, as shown by the award of the highest aggregate mark, in each of the following core course combinations:
  - Introductory Level German (GERM1021 and GERM1022);
  - Continuing Level German (GERM2103 and GERM2104);
  - Intermediate Level German (GERM2105 and GERM2106); or
  - Advanced Level German (GERM3007 and GERM3008).
- 4. A student is not eligible to be awarded the prize in any year if:
  - (i) the student is making a second or subsequent attempt at any of the courses; or
  - (ii) the student has previously pursued a course of study in a course, unit or subject (whether at the University or another tertiary education institution), the content of which is, in the opinion of the Dean of the ANU College of Arts and Social Sciences, substantially similar to the content of any of the courses for which the prize is to be awarded.
- 5. If, in any year, two or more students achieve the same top aggregate mark in a course combination, the prize awarded in that year shall be divided equally between them.
- 6. If, in any year, no student achieves results that, in the opinion of the Dean of the ANU College of Arts and Social Sciences, justify awarding the prize in that year, the prize shall not be awarded in that year.
