Graduate Studies in International Affairs Thesis Prize

Conditions of Award

1. There shall be a prize of \$200.00 for award for each graduating class which shall be known as the Graduate Studies in International Affairs Thesis Prize.
2. The prize shall be awarded in each graduating class to the student who was:
 - (i) enrolled in a program leading to the award of a degree of Master of Arts (International Relations) in the ANU College of Asia and the Pacific; and
 - (ii) awarded the highest agreed mark for the dissertation component of the Master of Arts (International Relations) in accordance with Graduate Studies in International Affairs examination procedures.
3. If, in any graduating class, two or more students achieve the same top mark, the prize awarded for that graduating class shall be divided equally between them.
4. If, in any graduating class, no student achieves results that, in the opinion of the Dean and Director of the ANU College of Asia and the Pacific, justify awarding the prize for that graduating class, the prize shall not be awarded for that graduating class.
