**KATE NORTH PRIZE**

**Conditions of Award**

1. There shall be a prize of \$350 for award each year which shall be known as the Kate North Prize.
2. The prize shall be awarded to the student who, in that year:
  - (i) was enrolled in a program in the ANU College of Arts and Social Sciences; and
  - (ii) achieved the best result as shown by the award of the highest aggregate mark in the courses which are in the field of Russian Literature, including but not limited to Russian IVH (RUSS4005).
3. If, in any year, no Russian courses as set out in clause 2 are offered, the prize may be awarded to a student of French who fulfils the conditions as set out in clause 2 where the word French replaces the word Russian.
4. A student is not eligible to be awarded the prize in any year if:
  - (i) the student is making a second or subsequent attempt at any of the courses; or
  - (ii) the student has previously pursued a course of study in a course, unit or subject (whether at the University or another tertiary education institution), the content of which is, in the opinion of the Dean of the ANU College of Arts and Social Sciences, substantially similar to the content of any of the courses for which the prize is to be awarded.
5. The prize may be awarded more than once to the same student.
6. If, in any year, two or more students equally merit the award of the prize, the prize in that year shall be divided equally between them.
7. If, in any year, no student achieves results that, in the opinion of the Dean of the ANU College of Arts and Social Sciences, justify awarding the prize, the prize shall not be awarded in that year.
