**LLEWELLYN CHOIR PRIZE FOR THE MOST OUTSTANDING  
INSTRUMENTALIST**

**Conditions of Award**

1. There shall be a prize for award each year which shall be known as the Llewellyn Choir Prize for the Most Outstanding Instrumentalist.
2. The value of the prize will be determined annually.
3. The prize shall be awarded to the student who, in that year:
  - (i) was enrolled in a program leading to the award of a degree offered by the ANU College of Arts and Social Sciences;
  - (ii) competed in the Margaret Smiles Accompaniment Competition as an instrumentalist; and
  - (iii) was, in the opinion of the Dean of the ANU College of Arts and Social Science acting on the advice of the Judging Panel, considered as the most outstanding instrumentalist in the Margaret Smiles Accompaniment Competition.
4. The prize will be awarded on the recommendation of a Judging Panel appointed by the Head of the School of Music.
5. If, in any year, two or more students merit the award of the prize, the prize awarded in that year shall be divided equally between them.
6. If, in any year, no student performs at the level that, in the opinion of the Dean of the ANU College of Arts and Social Sciences acting on the advice of the Judging Panel justifies awarding the prize in that year, the prize shall not be awarded in that year.
