MECHANICAL AND MANUFACTURING PRIZE
CONDITIONS OF AWARD

1. There shall be two prizes of \$500 for award each year which shall be known as the Mechanical and Manufacturing Prize.
2. The prizes shall be awarded to the students who, in that year:
 - (i) were enrolled in a Bachelor of Engineering (Research and Development) (Honours), Bachelor of Engineering (Honours), or associated double degree; and
 - (ii) achieved the best result as shown by the award of the highest mark in one of the following courses:
 - a. Manufacturing Technologies (ENGN3212).
 - b. Engineering Materials (ENGN3601)
3. If the courses cease to be offered, with the approval of the Dean of the ANU College of Engineering and Computer Science following discussion with the donor, the prize shall be awarded for other courses the content of which is similar.
4. If, in any year, two or more students achieve the same top mark in either of these courses, the prize awarded in that year shall be divided equally between them.
5. If, in any year, no students achieve results that, in the opinion of the Dean of the ANU College of Engineering and Computer Science, justify awarding the prizes in that year, the prizes shall not be awarded.
