**RICHARD B DAVIS PRIZE FOR THAI**

**Conditions of Award**

1. There shall be a prize of \$400 for award each year which shall be known as the Richard B Davis Prize for Thai.
2. The prize shall be awarded to the student who, in that year:
  - (i) was enrolled in a course leading to the award of the degree of Bachelor within the ANU College of Asia and the Pacific; and
  - (ii) achieved the best overall average mark for courses taken in third year Thai.
3. If a course ceases to be offered, the prize shall be awarded in respect of another course or courses the content of which is similar to the content of the advanced Thai Language courses offered by the ANU College of Asia and the Pacific.
4. A student is not eligible to be awarded the prize in that year if:
  - (i) the student is making a second or subsequent attempt at any of the courses; or
  - (ii) the student has previously pursued a course of study in a course, unit or subject (whether at the University or another tertiary education institution), the content of which, is in the opinion of the Dean and Director of the ANU College of Asia and the Pacific, substantially similar to the content of any of the courses for which the prize is to be awarded.
5. If, in that year, two or more students achieve the same top average mark, the prize awarded in that year shall be divided equally between them.
6. If, in that year, no student achieves results that, in the opinion of the Dean and Director of the ANU College of Asia and the Pacific, justify awarding the prize in that year, the prize shall not be awarded in that year.
