RURAL HEALTH PRIZE YEAR FOUR

Conditions of Award

1. There shall be a prize for award which shall be known as ANU Medical School Rural Health Prize Year Four.
2. The value of the prize is \$500.
3. The prize shall be awarded each year to the student who, in that year:
 - (i) was enrolled in Year Four of the Bachelor of Medicine Bachelor of Surgery Program;
 - (ii) has by end October, submitted up to 500 words describing their commitment to gaining experience in rural health care that was assessed as outstanding by the Selection Committee; and
 - (iii) demonstrated exceptional commitment to gaining experience in rural health care as assessed by the Selection Committee.
4. The members of the Selection Committee shall be drawn by the Dean from the School of General Practice Rural and Indigenous Health, ANU Medical School.
5. The prize may be shared.
6. If, in any year, no student is assessed as suitable by the Dean of the ANU Medical School, acting on the advice of the Selection Committee, the prize shall not be awarded in that year.

The ANU Medical School Year Four Prize for Rural Medicine is donated by Capital Pathology to highlight the importance of high quality rural medical education in the ACT and surrounding areas. The prize is for award annually to a final year Medical School student who has demonstrated exceptional commitment to gaining experience in rural health care.
