**SOUTHERN GENERAL PRACTICE NETWORK RURAL PRIZE**

1. There shall be a prize for award by Council that shall be known as the ANU Medical School Southern General Practice Network Rural Prize.
2. The value of the prize is \$1000.
3. The Prize shall be awarded each year, to the student who, in that year:
  - (i) was enrolled in Year Four of the Bachelor of Medicine Bachelor of Surgery Program;
  - (ii) completed a rural term or year in South East NSW in Year 3;
  - (iii) has been nominated by their rural GP supervisor as having exceptional interest, aptitude and commitment to rural general practice; and
  - (iv) has been further assessed by the Selection Committee.
4. The Dean and the School of General Practice Rural and Indigenous Health at the ANU Medical School shall draw the members of the Selection Committee with appropriate representation from rural general practice.
5. If, in any year, two students achieve the same level of excellence, the prize shall be divided equally between them.
6. If, in any year, no student is assessed as suitable by the Dean of the ANU Medical School acting on the advice of the Selection Committee, the prize shall not be awarded in that year.

*The ANU Medical School Rural General Practice Prize is sponsored by Southern General Practice Network annually to a third year medical student who has demonstrated exceptional interest, aptitude and commitment to rural general practice.*
