### SWISS EMBASSY PRIZES

#### AWARD CONDITIONS

1. There shall be a number of prizes for award by Council each year, which shall be known as the Swiss Embassy Prizes.
2. The Swiss Embassy Prizes endeavour to strengthen the interest in, and the study of the modern European languages spoken in Switzerland and their associated cultures and thus, to promote multilingualism and cultural diversity.
3. The prizes shall be awarded each year to the students who, in that year:
  - (i) were enrolled in a course leading to an award of a degree of Bachelor; and
  - (ii) submitted the best major piece of written work in the French or German or Italian language courses offered by the University and participating in the essay competition.
4. There may be up to three prizes awarded for written work in each language.
5. The value of the prizes shall be \$300 for the highest, \$200 for the second and \$100 for the third.
6. A student may be awarded a Swiss Embassy Prize on more than one occasion.
7. Each prize stands alone and shall not be shared.
8. If, in any year, the work submitted in French, German or Italian language courses is a group piece, then the students in the group will share the award, and the value of the prize will be divided equally between them.
9. If, in any year, no student submits written work in any of the relevant languages that, in the opinion of the Dean of the College, justifies awarding one or more than one of the prizes in that year, that prize shall not be awarded in that year.
