Research Integrity Test

The research integrity test will randomly present 20 questions from a question bank. The student will get two attempts to reach a passing grade of at least 16 out of 20 (or 80%).

All the answers for questions can be found in The ANU <u>Code of Research Conduct</u>, which the student should read before they attempt the test and have open to consult while they are doing it.

This document draws on the <u>Australian Code for the Responsible Conduct of Research</u>, which may be useful to consult for further detail, but is not essential reading.

6.	The Research Integrity Test page consists of 20 multiple choice questions selected at random. You must provide an answer to all questions. You must receive a mark of at least 16/20 or 80% in order to pass. The questions consist of both single answer and multiple answer questions.
	For single answer questions you must select one correct answer. Each question is worth one mark.

	For multiple answer questions you will receive a partial mark for every correct answer you select. If you select all the correct answers you will receive 1 mark. If you select an incorrect answer you will receive no marks.

If you fail the test you may attempt the test again by accessing it through your ISIS Milestone Reporting page. If you fail the test a second time, you must discuss this result with the Chair of your Supervisory Panel.
