HOW TO PLAN MY PROGRAM

This tool is not compulsory.

It can be used to help you plan your course selection more easily and to aid in any discussions with academic advisors.

This document is to be viewed in conjunction with your Program Outline in [Programs and Courses](#). Please refer to [Programs and Courses](#) FIRST for your Program Requirements when making course selections.

Use this information to complete the Course Selection Table on the next page.

As a **full-time student** you have **24 UNITS** in which to enrol **per Semester**. A course is usually made up of 6 units, but can also be 12 units, 24 units, or anywhere in between- you will need to check this by looking at the Course Outline.

If all of your courses are 6 units, you may enrol in 4 COURSES per Semester. You will be enrolling for the entire year, which means that you may need to choose 8 courses for your degree.

- **INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS** on a student visa **must** fill the **full 24** units each Semester.
- **DOMESTIC STUDENTS** need to study **at least 18** units each Semester to be considered full-time.
Enrolling in less than 24 units a semester is permissible for domestic students – however, it will extend the length of your program.

You will need the **COURSE TITLE** and **CODE**, and the **CLASS NUMBER** in order to complete the below table. To find these:

1. Search for and select your Course Outline in [Programs and Courses](#).
2. You will note both the **COURSE CODE** and **COURSE TITLE** immediately at the top of the page. This course title is “Methodologies of Art History”, and the course code is “ARTH8012”.

3. To find the **CLASS NUMBER**, scroll down to the “Terms” section. Here you will see the **CLASS NUMBER** field listed against the **SEMESTER**, on the left. Select the **CLASS NUMBER** for the Semester you are interested in enrolling in. For Semester 1, 2014, the class number for ARTH8012 was “4633”. Here you will also see your course dates, including the Census Date.
